

## Directions to the Godwin Cottage from Ottawa

If you have a GPS, you could set the destination for the turning point at the road to the parking spot at chemin du castor: +46° 11' 7.93", -75° 6' 13.16"

These instructions start with you proceeding east on Québec autoroute 50. The easiest way to do that is to take King Edward out of Ottawa, across the bridge to Québec and then follow the exit to Montréal.

There are other routes. If you take the Cumberland ferry to Masson you will arrive at route 148 est at Masson. Follow signs to Route 50 (straight ahead through town).

1. Take Québec Route 50 est (east) from the Ontario/Québec border.
2. Proceed to Exit 205 – Saint-André-Avellin.
3. Turn left (North) at T intersection onto route 321 nord (north)
4. Proceed through Saint-André-Avellin and remain on route 321.
5. Proceed through Chénéville (Oakville) and remain on route 321 to Duhamel.
6. Telephone (see below) from Chénéville or Duhamel so you will be expected.
7. You will arrive in Duhamel 25.7 km after leaving Chénéville.
8. Turn right at tee in Duhamel and you will pass a church. Keep going.
9. After you start driving beside the lake (on your right hand side) you will finally reach dirt road. Keep going.
10. You will reach a fork intersection. See circle on map. Do not take the right turn. Go straight or left.
11. You will cross a wooden bridge and pass a park reception centre. (Accueil Gagnon).
12. In 1.9 km from the fork you will reach a tee in the road.
13. Turn right onto route 6.
14. Proceed 6.55 km. You will see a sign on right of road labeled “Chemin du Castor”. Second circle on map.  
There is a large green garbage bin and some blue recycle bins just off the road.  
There are small KM markers along the Route 6. The turn off is between KM 22 and 23. Turn down this little road. You are here!
15. If the chain is across the road, you can easily unhook it. Rehook it after you pass.

Notes:

- If you cross another wooden bridge beside a lake, and just before a steep hill, you have gone too far. Turn around.
- When you arrive at the lake you are facing south and the island is to the east (left).

Call when you arrive. You should be able to get a cell signal there if you are on Bell or TELUS. We'll also keep an eye out for you. Or, if no phone service honk your horn three times
